Ministry Trainee?

Holy Trinity Church is offering the opportunity for someone to learn about the Lord Jesus Christ and to join in his mission by living, training, serving and teaching in the local church. We are looking for a ministry trainee who is prayerful, who loves Jesus Christ as Saviour, follows him as Lord, who wants to make a difference in the church and the world and is excited about learning to pastor and teach people about God from his word, the bible.

Who are we?

Holy Trinity West Bromwich (www.holytrinitywb.org) is a growing Anglican evangelical church in a very socially and ethnically mixed part of the West Midlands, in the Diocese of Lichfield. The average congregation at our main Sunday morning service is around 50 adults and 15 children. Our mission is to glorify God; love, accept, care and pray for one another; teach the next generation and to bless the people of West Bromwich by joyfully living out the good news and commandments of Jesus Christ together.

What do we do?

As well as Sunday services, we have a Junior Church and a team of enthusiastic teachers and helpers. We run midweek ministries of mercy: TNG youth group (11-15); Kidz Klub for primary school kids, a mothers and toddlers group, a drop-in for parents and a twice monthly social for older people. We have strong links with Holy Trinity C of E (Controlled) Primary School and do weekly assemblies and end of term services. Our vision is to see a small group established on every street in the parish.

Who are we looking for?

We are seeking a volunteer, who may be thinking of doing full time Christian ministry in the future and for whom mission to a multicultural and urban deprived community and estate would be good experience, to complete a one year training scheme at Holy Trinity. The scheme aims to develop a servant-hearted character and for you to be equipped with bible handling and leadership skills. You must be comfortable mixing with people from all backgrounds, classes and cultures.

What will the training scheme involve?

One day a week during term time will be taken up doing the Midlands Ministry Training Course (part of the Midlands Gospel Partnership) - www.mmtc.org.uk. Four days a week will be spent serving and teaching the bible in the church/parish (e.g. in Sunday School and Youth Group, kids club, assemblies & RE lessons at Holy Trinity School, holiday clubs, 1 to 1 bible reading, and occasional talks at our All-Age Sunday Services and where appropriate in one of our other Sunday services, and summer camp), and helping with a variety of practical and administrative tasks at church. Depending on your gifts there may also be other opportunities for ministry experience and involvement in church life, such as music and worship, catering, visiting and DIY.

As a trainee you will be assisted in your work by the Vicar, the Families and Community worker and other ministry leaders including another ministry trainee. Overall supervision would be the Vicar's responsibility. Pastoral care will be offered in a weekly one-to-one support meeting with the Vicar, at which we would also discuss and explore areas of theology using a suitable text book. You would also be expected to belong to a weekly Home Group.

What would the church provide?

A training grant sufficient to cover your living expenses will be provided. Accommodation will be provided in the vicarage, in the third floor, two bedroom self-contained flat. We encourage candidates to seek prayer and financial support to assist with the cost of training but this is not essential. All expenses will be met by the PCC, and you will be expected to take a full day-off each week and a minimum of 6 weeks annual leave. An enhanced CRB check would be necessary, at the parish's expense.
